

21 DAY EAST COAST TOUR

Day 1: Fly to Cairns where we are met by our coach and transferred to our accommodation.

Day 2: From Cairns we take one of Australia's most spectacular train journeys to Kuranda, a delightful mountain town set in lush rainforest. In the early afternoon our coach brings you back to Cairns. Alternatively you can return via the new Skyrail Rainforest Cableway. The afternoon is free time in Cairns. N.B. Kuranda rail journey included in your fare. Evening Meal not included. Skyrail trip not included, (cost approx \$40).

Day 3: Leaving beautiful Cairns it is south to Innisfail, a beautiful town on the Johnstone River, Ingham and Townsville. Magnetic Island is just off the coast and easily accessible by ferry. Townsville is the largest provincial city in Queensland.

Day 4: A leisurely drive south today through lush sugarcane fields to the beautiful Whitsunday area and Airlie Beach.

Day 5: A wonderful day out to the Whitsunday Islands. By this time everybody has fallen in love with the Queensland Coast. N.B. Boat trip to Whitsunday Islands included in your fare.

Day 6: A pleasant drive down the coast to Mackay and Rockhampton.

Day 7: Another lovely drive through the sugarcane and mountain scenery to Gympie and Nambour and the Ettamogah Pub, a recreation of the cartoon in the Pix Magazine; onto Buderim.

Day 8: Onto the Sunshine Coast and the rich pineapple growing areas. Our first stop is Nambour's Big Pineapple. Then onto Noosa Heads a real gem of a place. In the afternoon we move south along the coast to Maroochydore then Brisbane. Our tour of Brisbane begins with a visit to Mt. Coot-Tha overlooking the city and river, then into the city to view the sights. Free time in the city. N.B. Tour of Big Pineapple included.

Day 9: To the most easterly point in Australia, Cape Byron and famous Byron Bay. On then to the border towns of Tweeds Heads (NSW) and Coolangatta (QLD), the Gold Coast, Surfers Paradise and a visit to the Currumbin Bird Sanctuary. To our accommodation in Ballina. N.B. Currumbin Sanctuary included.

Day 10: A delightful drive along the Clarence and Richmond Rivers from Ballina, we come to Grafton and Coffs Harbour and visit the Big Banana. Onto Port Macquarie on the Hastings River. N.B. Entry to Big Banana included in your fare.

Day 11: On through the beautiful New South Wales North Coast to the industrial City of Newcastle on the banks of the Hunter River. Overnight at Swansea at the entrance to Lake Macquarie.

Day 12: A delightful day, along the Central Coast, then a very pleasant boat trip on the Hawkesbury River from Bobbin Head to Palm Beach. Through Narrabeen & Dee Why to Sydney for 3 nights N.B. Boat cruise included in your fare.

Day 13: A wonderful day in Sydney, visiting the beaches, Kings Cross, The Rocks, Opera House and the spectacular scenery of the Harbour. N.B. Evening meal not included

Day 14: This is your day to do as you will; visit friends, take a Harbour Cruise or simply take it easy. We take you to the nearest train station and pick you up that evening.

Day 15: Onto the Blue Mountains, Katoomba, its Three Sisters, Scenic Railway and Cable Car; a most impressive part of the world. Onto Canberra for 2 nights. N.B. Scenic Railway and Cable Car rides not included.

Day 16: A full day in Canberra visiting Parliament House, The National Museum, the National War Memorial and a tour of the Embassy District and City.

Day 17: Onto Cooma and into the Snowy Mountains and Thredbo at the foot of Mt. Kosciusko. We take the chairlift up the Mountain. Later down the Mountains to Eden. N.B. Chairlift included, weather permitting.

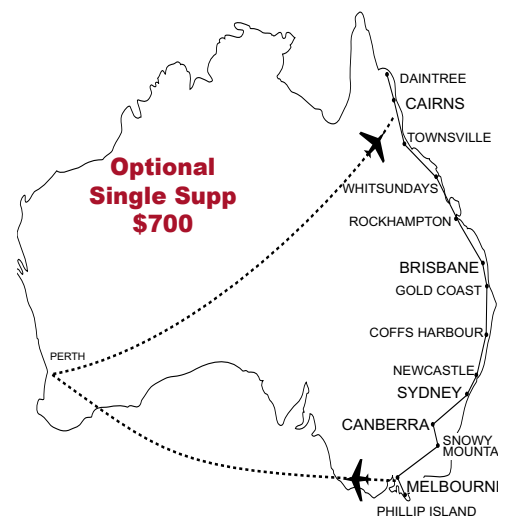
Day 20: Spend the day sightseeing cosmopolitan Melbourne including Port Phillip Bay, St Kilda, The War Memorial and free time in the city.
