

20 OR 17 DAY NULLARBOR & SOUTH EASTERN AUSTRALIA

CABIN / MOTEL TOUR

The first three days of this tour are for those who wish to experience the vastness of the Nullarbor Crossing. If not you may fly to Adelaide and join the tour on Day 4.

Price Includes:

- Airtfares
- Cabin / Motel Accommodation
- Most evening meals and breakfasts
- Entries to various attractions (as noted)

Day 1 & 2 are long days. There is no overnight tavel. Stops will be made at roadhouses for evening meals and accommodation will be at motels.

Day 1: We travel to Cunderdin visiting the original pumping station (now museum) for the Goldfields Pipe Line. From here we travel onto Merredin, Southern Cross and historic Coolgardie, our evening meal at Norseman. After tea, onto Cocklebidy. N.B. Entry at Cunderdin included in your fare. Evening meal is not included.

Day 2: Continuing across the Nullarbor into South Australia stopping to over look the cliffs of the Great Australian Bight and onto Ceduna for our evening stop. N.B. Evening meal not included.

Day 3: Through Kyancutta and Kimba to Port Augusta at the head of Spencer Gulf, first sailed by Matthew Flinders in 1802. We turn south here and onto Adelaide on the Gulf of St Vincent.

Day 4: We join up with the remaining passengers and commence a tour of Adelaide starting with Port Adelaide then the City Centre which was founded in 1836 and planned by Colonel William Light. We have free time in the city followed by an optional tram ride to Glenelg.

Day 5: A drive across the Fleurieu Peninsula to Victor Harbour, then to Goolwa on the mouth of the Murray River. From here we head through the Adelaide Hills to the beautiful Barossa Valley and the picturesque towns of Angaston and Nuriootpa. In the afternoon stop for a wine tasting in this world famous wine district. N.B. Wine tasting included in your fare.

Day 6: Off to the Mighty Murray River today

through Renmark the oldest European settlement on the Murray. Into Victoria and Mildura "The Fruit Bowl of Australia". In the afternoon a delightful cruise on an historic Paddleboat. N.B. Paddleboat cruise included in your fare.

Day 7: An early start for our drive across Outback NSW, to Hay, Narrandera, Wagga Wagga and a visit to the "Dog on the Tucker Box" 5 Mile from Gundagai. Then onto Canberra for three nights.

Day 8: We tour the National Capital including the Embassy District, the War Memorial, the City, Parliament House and the National Museum. N.B. Entries included in your fare.

Day 9: We travel via Jindabyne to the Snowy Mountains and Thredbo at the foot of Mt. Kosciusko. Here you may take the chairlift up the mountain. In the afternoon down the mountains to Cooma and back to Canberra. N.B. Chairlift included in your fare, weather permitting.

Day 10: Onto the Blue Mountains, Katoomba, its Three Sisters, Scenic Railway and Cable Car; a most impressive part of the world, to Sydney for 3 nights. NB Scenic Railway and Cable Car rides not included.

Day 11: A wonderful day in Sydney, visiting the beaches, Kings Cross, The Rocks, Opera House and the spectacular scenery of the Harbour. N.B. Evening meal not included

Day 12: Sydney; This is your day to do as you will; visit friends, take a Harbour Cruise or simply take it easy. We take you to the nearest train station and pick you up that evening.

Day 13: A delightful day, along the northern beaches, Dee Why and Narrabeen to Palm Beach. Then a very pleasant boat trip on the Hawkesbury River to Bobbin Head, where the coach is waiting. Later we visit the some of the Sydney 2000 Olympic sites. N.B. Boat cruise included in your fare.

Day 14: South today we move onto the very beautiful NSW south coast past Wollongong, Nowra and Batemans Bay.

Day 15: Continuing along the South Coast we cross into Victoria and Orbost, Lakes Entrance and Sale, then onto Melbourne for three nights.

Day 16: City sightseeing of cosmopolitan Melbourne including the War Memorial and free time in the city.

Day 17: A trip on the Puffing Billy Steam Train from Belgrave to Lakeside. In the afternoon onto Phillip Island and its famous Penguin Parade. N.B. Puffing Billy and Penguin Parade included, evening meal not included.

Day 18: Onto the industrial city of Geelong and then for a delightful drive along the Great Ocean Road viewing its spectacular 12 Apostles. Spending the night at Warrnambool.

Day 19: Onto Portland, one of the earliest settlements in Victoria and home of Alcoa's huge aluminium smelter. Onto Mt Gambier; its volcanic Blue Lake is very interesting. From here we move onto Murray Bridge.

Day 20: Onto the beautiful Adelaide Hills and the delightful town of Hahndorf where we have plenty of time to wander. Later onto Adelaide and our flight home.

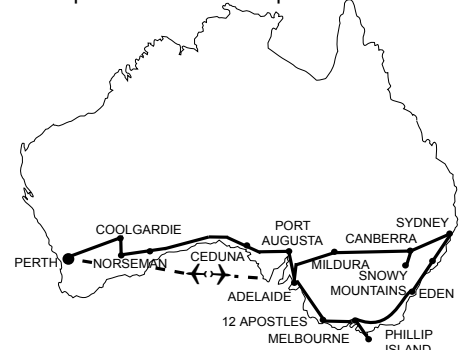
