

11 DAY MT AUGUSTUS, KARIJINI, EXMOUTH, CORAL BAY & MONKEY MIA

CABIN / MOTEL TOUR

Price Includes:

- Cabin / Motel Accommodation
- Most evening meals and breakfasts
- Entries to various attractions (as noted)

Note - This is a tour in the remote Outback areas, where accommodation is limited. On two of the nights the accommodation does not have ensuite facilities. Ensuite facilities means toilet and shower inside the cabin or apartment.

Day 1: Via the picturesque Swan Valley to New Norcia for a morning tea break and look around. On via Dalwallinu and Wubin along the Great Northern Highway and the Paynes Find Pub where we have a break, then move onto the Gold Mining Town of Mt Magnet and our accommodation. (Budget Motel with ensuite)

Day 2: Onto Cue, an historic goldmining town, then to Meekatharra. We leave the bitumen travelling to Mt. Gould police station, built in the late 1800's to police Aborigines who were killing settlers' stock. Lunch then onto Landor Station, famous for its bush race meeting. Onto Mt. Augustus. N.B. Lunch Included (Cabins without ensuite)

Day 3: At Mt. Augustus we enjoy a tour and visit to nearby Lyons River. After lunch it is rest and relax in this outback oasis. N.B. Lunch Included (Cabins without ensuite)

Day 4: Heading North from Mount Augustus we travel along side the Ashburton River, crossing at Ashburton Downs and on via Paraburdoo to Tom Price. Tom Price is at the centre of the great Iron Ore industry of our Pilbara. In the evening we enjoy a bush BBQ in the spectacular Pilbara Scenery. N.B. Lunch Included (Motel)

Day 5: We do a conducted tour of the mine then into Karijini National Park, some of the Gorges we see today are as impressive as any you would see in Australia. We visit Dales Gorge, Circular Pool and Fortescue Falls. N.B. Tour of Tom Price mine included in your fare. Lunch Included (Motel)

Day 6: Departing Tom Price we travel via Paraburdoo to Nanutarra on the Ashburton River. Exmouth is a most unusual place. It is the centre for the Navy Nor-West Cape Base. We travel to the head of the Gulf then return to town and our accommodation. (Motel)

Day 7: Up to Cape Range National Park and the spectacular scenery of Charles Knife Road, where oil was first found in Western Australia in the 1950's. Then Coral Bay for a glass bottom boat cruise to view the beautiful coral of Ningaloo Reef. Then to our accommodation at Carnarvon. N.B. Lunch included, Boat Cruise Included. (Motel)

Day 8: We visit the Babbage Island Jetty and the Fishing Harbour. This is the old North West, sheep station country, where so many over the last 100 years have battled drought and the great floods. Further south we spend the night at Nanga Station. (Motel)

Day 9: Visit Monkey Mia to see those magnificent creatures of the wild "Dolphins". Also Denham, most Westerly town in Australia. Hamelin Pool to see the ancient Stromatolites and Hamelin Pool Telegraph Station. Later onto Kalbarri. (2 bedroom apartments with ensuite)

Day 10: See the spectacular Murchinson River Gorges, the Z bend & The Loop and Red Bluff. Return to Kalbarri for a relaxing afternoon with optional River Cruise and visit to Rainbow Jungle. N.B. Entry to Kalbarri Gorges included. River Cruise and Rainbow Jungle not included. (2 bedroom apartments with ensuite)

Day 11: To Geraldton, via the new coastal road past Hutt Lagoon to Port Gregory. Onto the former convict station of Lynton, then to Northampton and Geraldton for lunch, a tour and a visit to HMAS Sydney Memorial. Afternoon return to Perth at 6pm.

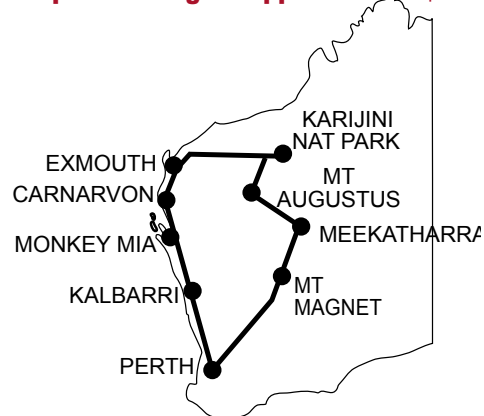
