

11 DAY BROOME, KARIJINI, EXMOUTH, CORAL BAY, MONKEY MIA & KALBARRI

Note - This is a tour in the remote Outback areas, where accommodation is limited. On two of the nights the accommodation does not have ensuite facilities. Ensuite facilities means toilet and shower inside the cabin or apartment.

Day 1: Up the Brand Highway to Dongara for lunch, a visit to HMAS Sydney Memorial in Geraldton. Onto Northampton then to the former convict station of Lynton, on via the new coastal road past Hutt Lagoon to Kalbarri.

Day 2: See the spectacular Murchinson River Gorges, the Z bend & The Loop and Red Bluff. Return to Kalbarri for a relaxing afternoon with optional River Cruise and visit to Rainbow Jungle. N.B. Entry to Kalbarri Gorges included. River Cruise and Rainbow Jungle not included.

Day 3: Visit Monkey Mia to see those magnificent creatures of the wild "Dolphins". Also Denham, most Westerly town in Australia. Hamelin Pool to see the ancient Stromatolites and Hamelin Pool Telegraph Station. Later onto Nanga Station.

Day 4: North to Carnarvon at the mouth of the Gascoyne River, a very productive banana, grape and mango growing area, for lunch. Then onto Exmouth, our home for two nights.

Day 5: Exmouth is a most unusual place. It is the centre for the Navy Nor-West Cape Base. We travel to the head of the Gulf then return to town. Later onto Cape Range

National Park and the spectacular scenery of Charles Knife Road, where oil was first found in Western Australia in the 1950's. Then onto Coral Bay for a glass bottom boat cruise to view the beautiful coral of Ningaloo Reef. N.B. Boat Cruise Included.

Day 6: Departing Exmouth we travel via Nanutarra on the Ashburton River to Parabadoo. Then to our accommodation at Tom Price for two nights. In the evening we enjoy a bush BBQ in the spectacular Pilbara Scenery.

Day 7: Into Karijini National Park, some of the Gorges we see today are as impressive as any you would see in Australia. We visit Dales Gorge, Circular Pool and Fortescue Fall.

Return to Tom Price for a conducted tour of the Iron Ore mine. N.B. Tour of Tom Price mine included in your fare.

Day 8: Onto Port Hedland one of the huge Iron Ore ports in the North West. We view the town and the loading facilities.

Day 9: Further North we drive between the Great Sandy Desert and the sea via Pardoo & Sandfire roadhouses to the Pearl in the crown of the North West, Broome for two

nights.

Day 10: A wonderful day relaxing in Broome, a lovely historic old pearling town. Visit Chinatown, the Japanese Cemetery, Roebuck Bay and have a full tour of the town. You might like a camel ride. on the beach. We have a fish and chips evening meal watching the sunset over Cable Beach.

Day 11: A drive out to Malcom Douglas Wildlife Park is view some of the wonderful native animals of Nothern / Western Australia. We fly home after a great experience of Western Australia. N.B. Wildlife Park entry included.

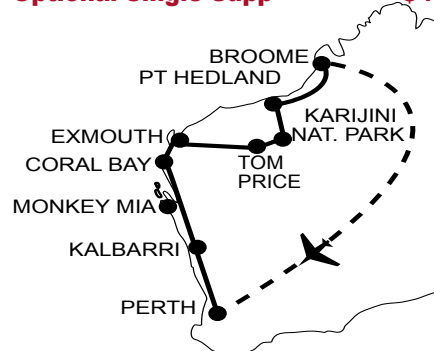
