Day 8 & 9 are long days. There is no overnight travel. Stops will be made at roadhouses for evening meals and accommodation will be at motels.

Day 1: Fly from Perth to Adelaide, where we are met by our coach. Our tour of Adelaide commences with a drive to Semaphore and Port Adelaide. Then a tour of Adelaide City and surrounds, with free time to explore this delightful city. In the afternoon there is an optional tram ride to Glenelg. We are met by the coach and settle into the accommodation for two nights at McLaren Vale. NB. Tram ride not included in your fare.

Day 2: We follow the Torrens River today through the Chain of Ponds to the picturesque Adelaide Hills and the town of Birdwood, visiting the National Car Museum, the premier car museum in Australia. This is not just a museum for car enthusiasts, it contains many unique vehicles of great historical importance. From Birdwood we continue through the hills to Hahndorf, a quaint town reflecting its colourful German Heritage. After lunch it is to Goolwa, the Mouth of the Murray River & Victor Harbour NB. Entry into Car Museum included in your fare

Day 3: Off we go to the beautiful Barossa

Valley and the delightful towns of Tanunda, Angaston and Nurioopta. In the morning we have a tour and wine tasting. After lunch its on to the Murray River for an afternoon cruise on Australia's most important river. Later onto Murray Bridge, site of the first permanent crossing of the river. NB. Winery Tour and Murray River Cruise included in your fare

Day 4: Leaving Murray Bridge we move on to the great Heritage Copper Mining town of Burra, which has a special place in Australian Heritage Law via the "Burra Charter", the whole town is classified by the National Trust. During our stay in Burra we have a guided tour of the town. In the afternoon it is further north to Jamestown, Orroroo and out home for two nights at Hawker. (Two bedroom apartment accommodation).

Day 5: Today there is a great drive through the spectacular Flinders Ranges, where some of the best Outback Scenery in Australia abounds. Wilpena Pound is a special spot to visit today. (Two bedroom apartment accommodation).

Day 6: Leaving the Flinders we travel via Pichi-Richi Pass to Port Augusta, the Outback Gateway at the head of the Spencers Gulf. Later onto Whyalla, which was founded as Hummock's Hill in 1901 by the Broken Hill Proprietary Company (BHP) as the end of a tramway bringing iron ore from the Middleback Ranges. Onto Port Lincoln, named after the home town of Matthew Flinders who first visited this area in 1802.

Day 7: From Port Lincoln we drive up the West Coast of the Eyre Peninsula. Through Streaky Bay to Ceduna.

Day 8: Heading out across the Nullarbor to

look over the cliffs of the Great Australian Bight and into Western Australia stopping for our evening stop at Balladonia. N.B. Evening meal not included.

Day 9: We travel to Norseman then North to historic Coolgardie. Towards Perth we follow the Goldfields Pipe Line visiting Southern Cross, Merredin and Cunderdin. We arrive back in Perth late this evening. N.B. Evening meal not included.

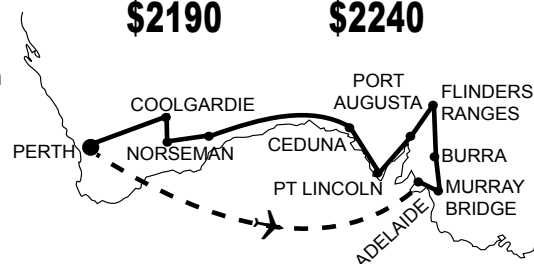
